

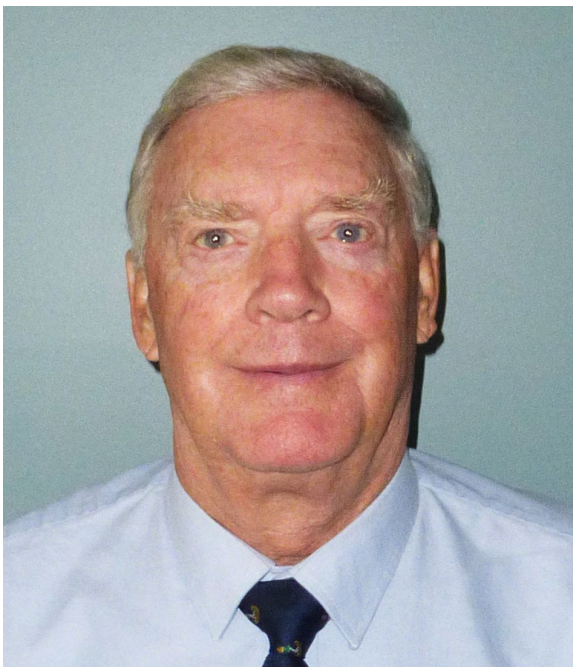

- Served as an Instructor on Chipmunk and Tutor aircraft
- Served as a pilot on Caribou aircraft for United Nation operations in Kashmir
- Flew RCAF Cosmopolitan aircraft in Ottawa and Colorado Springs
- Flew Viscount, Jetstar, and Challenger aircraft with Transport Canada Executive Flight
- Flew DC10, B747, and A310 aircraft with Wardair Canada
- Flew A310, A300-600, A330-200, and B777 aircraft for Emirates Airline out of Dubai
- Retired from Emirates in 2000 as General Manager Flight Training
