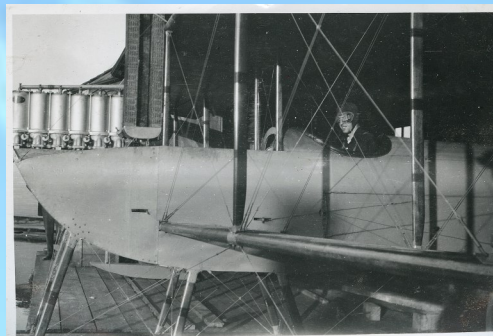

Speaker Night Robert Hopkins

Wednesday 16 May from 7 - 9 pm
The Roberts and the Hoffar

The heart of an airplane is its engine. When the Hoffar Brothers set out in 1916 to build their historic H -1 they chose a Roberts 6X motor. This was a marine engine adapted for the burgeoning aviation sector.



Robert will examine the roots and technology of this pioneering engine and will explain how it is being replicated for the museum project. This

includes an unusual mix of revolutionary 3-D printing and new and vintage parts.

Robert worked for 35 years as a licensed Marine Engineer with the Royal Canadian Navy and BC Ferries. A long-time model railroader, he has also restored and refurbished most of the BC Aviation Museum's display motors.
