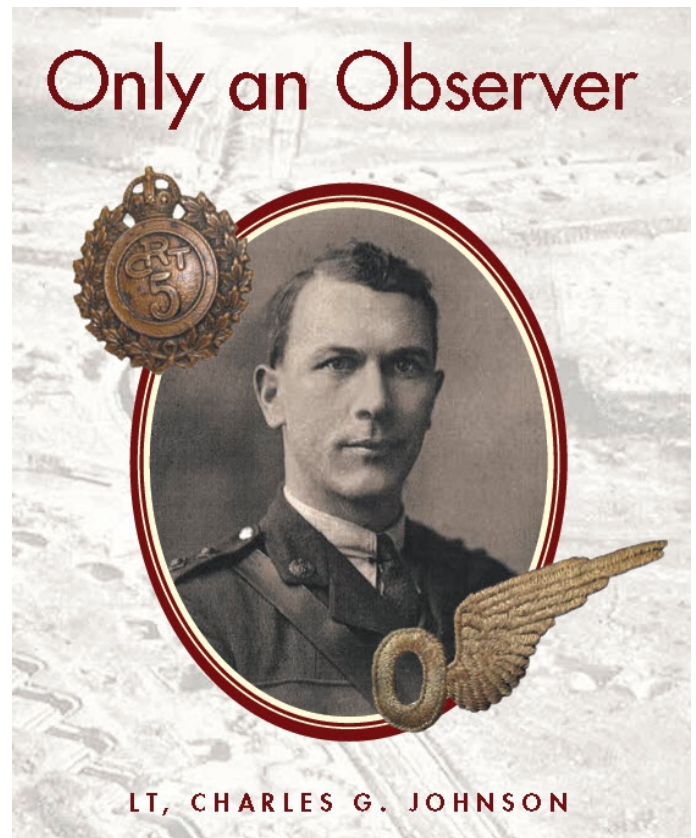
Only an Observer

Lt. Charles G Johnson served 3 years on the Western Front during World War 1 with the Canadian Army. He spent the first two years building railways at the front and in the last year of the war he spent in excess of 400 hours flying over the front with the Royal Flying Corp/Royal Air Force. In the 1960s Charles wrote from memory about his experiences during those years but it was never published.



The Co-Author:
Brian Johnson is a retired Civil Engineer with a life long interest in history and a particular interest in World Wars 1 & 2. His interest in his grandfather's story

started in his teens. Last year being the 100th anniversary of the end of WW1 Brian edited Charles' original manuscript, added some context and Charles' personal history and had the memoir published.
